Current situation and the problem

A World Bank study revealed that globally, around 4.8 to 12.7 million tonnes of plastic leak into our ocean every year with Asia contributing about 80 percent of this leakage.

The Philippines is the third largest contributor of mismanaged plastic entering the ocean each year.



Million metric tonnes of mismanaged plastic Only of the key plastic resins were recycled in 2019

The World Bank identified <mark>4 key challenges</mark> that lead to the difficulty in managing solid waste in the Philippines:



- 1. Mixed waste collection
- 2. Inadequate infrastructure
- 3. Limited public funds and technical capacity to cover full SWM services at the LGU level

4. Lack of recycling capacity

DOF Recommendation

The proposed excise tax on plastic bags is the Philippines's contribution to the global movement to reduce pollution and adopt more sustainable practices.

KEY FEATURES: Excise Tax on Single-Use Plastic



Single-use plastic bags such as "ice", "labo", or "sando" bags, with or without handle, used as packaging for goods or products

Tax Rate



P100 per kilogram, indexed at 4 percent annually beginning January 1, 2026

Use of Incremental Revenues



All revenues shall be earmarked for DENR's solid waste management programs in municipalities
